I. Purpose:

A regulation to prohibit littering at Rowan College of South Jersey (RCSJ), Cumberland Campus, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for the failure to comply.

II. Definitions:

For the purpose of this regulation, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this regulation demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

- a. <u>Litter</u> any used or unconsumed substance or waste material which has been discarded, whether made of aluminum, glass, plastic, rubber, paper, or other natural or synthetic material, or any combination thereof, including, but not limited to, any bottle, jar or can, or any top, cap or detachable tab of any bottle, jar or can, any unlighted cigarette, cigar, match or any flaming or glowing material or any garbage, trash, refuse, debris, rubbish, grass clippings or other lawn or garden waste, newspapers, magazines, glass, metal, plastic or paper containers or other packaging or construction material, but does not include the waste of the primary processes of mining or other extraction processes, logging, sawmilling, farming or manufacturing.
- b. <u>Litter Receptacle</u> a container suitable for the depositing of litter.
- c. <u>Person</u> any individual (including but not limited to a RCSJ student; visiting faculty member or other visitor; guest; professional member of the RCSJ's academic, administrative, or teaching staff; or other RCSJ officer, agent, or employee), corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State whose conduct on RCSJ property is subject to regulation by RCSJ.
- d. <u>University</u> Rowan College of South Jersey (RCSJ), Cumberland Campus.
- e. <u>University property</u> Lands and buildings owned or controlled by RCSJ, Cumberland Campus.

III. Prohibited Conduct:

No person shall throw, drop, discard or otherwise place any litter of any nature upon RCSJ property other than in a litter receptacle, or having done so to allow such litter to remain.

Whenever any litter is thrown or discarded or allowed to fall from a vehicle or boat in violation of this regulation, the operator or owner, or both, of the motor vehicle or boat shall also be deemed to have violated this regulation.

IV. Violations:

- a. Any RCSJ student who is found to be in violation of this regulation shall be subject to official warning, disciplinary probation, suspension, expulsion, or other sanctions in accordance with the RCSJ's Student Conduct Code.
- b. Any RCSJ officer, staff member, employee, or agent who is found to be in violation of this regulation shall be subject to dismissal, removal, reduction of salary, suspension, demotion, or other disciplinary action in accordance with applicable New Jersey statutes and relevant contracts or agreements.
- c. Any other person who has entered into a contract or agreement with RCSJ to provide equipment, materials, supplies, or services on RCSJ property, and who is found to be in violation of this regulation, shall be subject to sanctions in accordance with the contract or agreement.
- d. Any visitor, guest, or other person who is not identified under IV(a), IV(b), or IV(c) above, and who is found to be in violation of this regulation, is subject to ejection from RCSJ property and, if the person refuses to leave after being asked to leave, to prosecution for criminal trespass under N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3.
- e. Any person who throws, drops, discards or otherwise places any litter of any nature upon RCSJ property other than in a litter receptacle is also subject to prosecution under applicable New Jersey statutes.

Subject: Wildlife Feeding Control

I. Purpose:

A regulation to prohibit the feeding of unconfined wildlife at Rowan College of South Jersey, Cumberland Campus, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for failure to comply.

II. Definitions:

For the purpose of this regulation, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this regulation clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

- a. <u>Feed</u> to give, place, expose, deposit, distribute or scatter any edible material with the intention of feeding, attracting or enticing wildlife. Feeding does not include baiting in the legal taking of fish and/or game.
- b. <u>Person</u> any individual (including but not limited to a RCSJ student; visiting faculty member or other visitor; guest; professional member of the RCSJ's academic, administrative, or teaching staff; or other RCSJ officer, agent, or employee), corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State whose conduct on RCSJ property is subject to regulation by RCSJ.
- c. University Rowan College of South Jersey (RCSJ), Cumberland Campus.
- d. <u>University property</u> Lands and buildings owned or controlled by RCSJ, Cumberland Campus.
- e. Wildlife all animals that are neither human nor domesticated.

III. Prohibited Conduct:

No person shall feed any unconfined wildlife on RCSJ property, except as part of academic research.

IV. Violations:

- a. Any RCSJ student who is found to be in violation of this regulation shall be subject to official warning, disciplinary probation, suspension, expulsion, or other sanctions in accordance with the RCSJ's Student Conduct Code.
- b. Any RCSJ officer, staff member, employee, or agent who is found to be in violation of this regulation shall be subject to dismissal, removal, reduction of salary, suspension, demotion, or other disciplinary action in accordance with applicable New Jersey statutes and relevant contracts or agreements.
- c. Any other person who has entered into a contract or agreement with RCSJ to provide equipment, materials, supplies, or services on RCSJ property, and who is found to be in violation of this regulation, shall be subject to sanctions in accordance with the contract or agreement.
- d. Any visitor, guest, or other person who is not identified under IV(a), IV(b), or IV(c) above, and who is found to be in violation of this regulation, is subject to ejection from RCSJ property and, if the person refuses to leave after being asked to leave, to prosecution for criminal trespass under N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3.

Subject: Pet Waste Control

I. Purpose:

A regulation to establish requirements for the proper disposal of pet solid waste at Rowan College of South Jersey, Cumberland Campus, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for failure to comply.

II. Definitions:

For the purpose of this regulation, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this regulation clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

- a. <u>Immediate</u> shall mean that the pet solid waste is removed at once, without delay.
- b. Owner/Keeper any person who shall possess, maintain, house or harbor any pet or otherwise have custody of any pet, whether or not the owner of such pet.
- c. <u>Person</u> any individual (including but not limited to a RCSJ student; visiting faculty member or other visitor; guest; professional member of the RCSJ's academic, administrative, or teaching staff; or other RCSJ officer, agent, or employee), corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State whose conduct on RCSJ property is subject to regulation by RCSJ.
- d. <u>Pet</u> a domesticated animal kept for amusement or companionship rather than utility.
- e. <u>Pet solid waste</u> waste matter expelled from the bowels of the pet, excrement.

- f. Proper disposal placement in a designated waste receptacle, or other suitable container, and discarded in a refuse container which is regularly emptied by RCSJ or some other refuse collector; or disposal into a system designed to convey domestic sewage for proper treatment and disposal.
- g. <u>University</u> Rowan College of South Jersey (RCSJ), Cumberland Campus.
- h. <u>University property</u> Lands and buildings owned or controlled by RCSJ, Cumberland Campus.

III. Requirement for Disposal:

All pet owners and keepers are required to immediately and properly dispose of their pet's solid waste deposited on RCSJ property.

IV. Exemptions:

Any owner or keeper who requires the use of a disability assistance animal shall be exempt from the provisions of this regulation while such animal is being used for that purpose.

V. Violations:

- a. Any RCSJ student who is found to be in violation of this regulation shall be subject to official warning, disciplinary probation, suspension, expulsion, or other sanctions in accordance with the RCSJ's Student Conduct Code.
- b. Any RCSJ officer, staff member, employee, or agent who is found to be in violation of this regulation shall be subject to dismissal, removal, reduction of salary, suspension, demotion, or other disciplinary action in accordance with applicable New Jersey statutes and relevant contracts or agreements.
- c. Any other person who has entered into a contract or agreement with RCSJ to provide equipment, materials, supplies, or services on RCSJ property, and who is found to be in violation of this regulation, shall be subject to sanctions in accordance with the contract or agreement.
- d. Any visitor, guest, or other person who is not identified under V(a), V(b), or V(c) above, and who is found to be in violation of this regulation, is subject to ejection from RCSJ property and, if the person refuses to leave after being asked to leave, to prosecution for criminal trespass under N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3.

Subject: Pets

I. Purpose:

A regulation to prohibit pets at Rowan College of South Jersey, Cumberland Campus, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for failure to comply.

II. Definitions:

For the purpose of this regulation, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this regulation clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

- a. <u>Owner/Keeper</u> any person who shall possess, maintain, house or harbor any pet or otherwise have custody of any pet, whether or not the owner of such pet.
- b. <u>Person</u> any individual (including but not limited to a RCSJ student; visiting faculty member or other visitor; guest; professional member of the RCSJ's academic, administrative, or teaching staff; or other RCSJ officer, agent, or employee), corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State whose conduct on RCSJ property is subject to regulation by RCSJ.
- c. <u>Pet</u> a domesticated animal kept for amusement or companionship rather than utility.
- d. University Rowan College of South Jersey (RCSJ), Cumberland Campus.
- e. <u>University property</u> Lands and buildings owned or controlled by RCSJ, Cumberland Campus.

III. Prohibited Conduct:

No person shall possess, maintain, house or harbor any pet or otherwise have custody of any pet on RCSJ property.

IV. Exemptions to Prohibition:

Any owner or keeper who requires the use of a disability assistance animal shall be exempt from the provisions of this regulation while such animal is being used for that purpose.

V. Violations:

- a. Any RCSJ student who is found to be in violation of this regulation shall be subject to official warning, disciplinary probation, suspension, expulsion, or other sanctions in accordance with the RCSJ's Student Conduct Code.
- b. Any RCSJ officer, staff member, employee, or agent who is found to be in violation of this regulation shall be subject to dismissal, removal, reduction of salary, suspension, demotion, or other disciplinary action in accordance with applicable New Jersey statutes and relevant contracts or agreements.
- c. Any other person who has entered into a contract or agreement with RCSJ to provide equipment, materials, supplies, or services on RCSJ property, and who is found to be in violation of this regulation, shall be subject to sanctions in accordance with the contract or agreement.
- d. Any visitor, guest, or other person who is not identified under V(a), V(b), or V(c) above, and who is found to be in violation of this regulation, is subject to ejection from RCSJ property and, if the person refuses to leave after being asked to leave, to prosecution for criminal trespass under N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3.

Subject: Improper Disposal of Waste into Storm Sewers on RCSJ Property

I. Purpose:

A regulation to prohibit the spilling, dumping, or disposal of materials other than stormwater to the municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) operated by Rowan College of South Jersey (RCSJ), Cumberland Campus, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for the failure to comply.

II. Definitions:

For the purpose of this regulation, the following terms, phrases, words, and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this regulation clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

- a. <u>Municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4)</u> a conveyance or system of conveyances (including roads with drainage systems, municipal streets, catch basins, curbs, gutters, ditches, manmade channels, or storm drains) that is owned or operated by RCSJ or other public body, and is designed and used for collecting and conveying stormwater.
- b. <u>Person</u> any individual (including but not limited to a RCSJ student; visiting faculty member or other visitor; guest; professional member of the RCSJ's academic, administrative, or teaching staff; or other RCSJ officer, agent, or employee), corporation (including RCSJ, Cumberland Campus), company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State whose conduct on RCSJ property is subject to regulation by RCSJ.
- c. <u>Stormwater</u> water resulting from precipitation (including rain and snow) that runs off the land's surface, is transmitted to the subsurface, is captured by

separate storm sewers or other sewerage or drainage facilities or is conveyed by snow removal equipment.

- d. <u>University</u> Rowan College of South Jersey (RCSJ), Cumberland Campus.
- e. <u>University property</u> lands and buildings owned or controlled by RCSJ, Cumberland Campus.

III. Prohibited Conduct:

All persons are prohibited while on RCSJ property from:

- a. Spilling, dumping, or disposing of materials other than stormwater to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by RCSJ.
- b. Spilling, dumping, or disposing of materials other than stormwater in such a manner as to cause the discharge of pollutants to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by RCSJ.

IV. Exceptions

- a Water line flushing and discharges from potable water sources.
- b. Uncontaminated ground water (e.g., infiltration, crawl space or basement sump pumps, foundation or footing drains, rising ground waters).
- Air conditioning condensate (excluding contact and non-contact cooling water).
- d. Irrigation water (including landscape and lawn watering runoff).
- e. Flows from springs, riparian habitats and wetlands, water reservoir discharges and diverted stream flows.
- f. Residential car washing water, and residential swimming pool discharges.
- g. Sidewalk, driveway, and street wash water.
- h. Flows from firefighting activities.
- Elows from rinsing of the following equipment with clean water:
 - 1. Beach maintenance equipment immediately following their use for their intended purposes; and
 - a Equipment used in the application of salt and de-icing materials immediately following salt and de-icing material applications. Prior to rinsing with clean water, all residual salt and de-icing materials must be removed from equipment and vehicles to the maximum extent practicable using dry cleaning methods (e.g., shoveling and sweeping). Recovered materials are to be returned to storage for reuse or properly discarded.

Rinsing of equipment in the above situations is limited to exterior, undercarriage, and exposed parts and does not apply to engines or other enclosed machinery.

V. Violations:

- a Any RCSJ student who continues to be in violation of this regulation, after being duly notified, shall be subject to official warning, disciplinary probation, suspension, expulsion, or other sanctions in accordance with the RCSJ's Student Conduct Code.
- b. Any RCSJ officer, staff member, employee, or agent who continues to be in violation of this regulation, after being duly notified, shall be subject to dismissal, removal, reduction of salary, suspension, demotion, or other disciplinary action in accordance with applicable New Jersey statutes and relevant contracts or agreements.
- Any other person who has entered into a contract or agreement with RCSJ to provide equipment, materials, supplies, or services on RCSJ property, and who continues to be in violation of this regulation, after being duly notified, shall be subject to sanctions in accordance with the contract or agreement.
- d. Any visitor, guest, or other person who is not identified under V(a), V(b), or V(c) above, and who continues to be in violation of this regulation, after being duly notified, is subject to ejection from RCSJ property and, if the person refuses to leave after being asked to leave, to prosecution for criminal trespass under N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3.
- e. Any person who violates this regulation may also be subject to prosecution under applicable New Jersey statutes.
