Notes:

- All admissions requirements for the current application cycle are in the program's admissions packet.
- Applicants may only apply to **one** selective admissions program per application cycle.
- For an individualized plan to program application, students should meet with their academic advisor early in the application process. Some applicants may need to take remedial courses and other prerequisites before application.
- Registration for the Residual ACT is in-person at the Gloucester Testing Center. Plan ahead!
- Applicants only need to attend one information session per year for their program of choice.
