The following courses can be taken at RCBC to transfer in as general education courses toward the Generic Nursing (RN) program at Rowan College South Jersey - Gloucester Campus. Please keep in mind that these courses may have prerequisites as determined by your RCBC academic advisor.

Program Required Science Courses:

*RCBC separates the lecture and lab for most science courses. Students need to earn a letter grade of C+ or better in **both** portions to be able to transfer the course.*

Other Program Required General Education Courses:

Students can have a "C" grade in these courses.

Notes for Prospective Applicants:

- ✓ Previous NUR courses will **not** transfer to the RCSJ Nursing program – all applicants accepted through the portfolio process will begin with first semester courses and complete the program in sequence.
- ✓ The RCSJ Nursing program requires only six general education courses (listed above) to earn the AAS Nursing degree. Additional courses taken at RCBC required for their AAS Nursing degree may not transfer to RCSJ.
- ✓ RCSJ admits a cohort of Nursing students once per year. Applicants will submit a portfolio in the spring to start NURS courses in the fall semester (if accepted).

Final transferability of coursework is determined by Rowan College South Jersey, Gloucester/Cumberland Campuses.
